Riveredge is happy to provide before and after camp extended care for our full day campers. Our programs allow campers to spend just a little more time exploring Riveredge with earlier drop off (7:30 am) and/or later pick up (5:30 pm) with daily or weekly options. Camp counselors will encourage your camper's imagination through games and activities and they will have plenty of time for free play in our natural playground. An option will be given during registration to receive more information on extended care options. *Extended care not available following an overnight program*.

Tree Climbing

Explore Riveredge at a new elevation! Our Tree Climbing programs are meant for youth ages 7 and above and adults with little to no tree climbing skills. Ascend ropes and explore the world way above your feet. We make it safe and easy! All equipment is supplied; all you need is loose clothing (T-shirt and long pants recommended), closed toe shoes (hard soles recommended), and an adventurous spirit. All climbers must be accompanied by an adult.



Geocaching Adventure

Come out for this hiking treasure hunt! You will use a GPS unit to find your way to several hidden caches along the Riveredge trails. It's a great way to bond as a family and learn essential navigational skills. GPS units will be provided by your adventure educator. Participants should be able to hike 2 miles. Please bring a sample treasure to hide or trade!



Tubing the Milwaukee River

Ages 7 and up with an adult Thursday, June 20, 1-3:30 pm Friday, June 28, 1-3:30 pm

After a quick tour of the Sturgeon Streamside Rearing Facility, we'll hop on inner tubes and float down the Milwaukee River. Along the way, we'll discover the diversity of living things that make their home in the river. Wear sturdy shoes and clothing that can get wet. Bring a lifejacket and inner tube if you have them. Children must be accompanied by an adult. Participants should be able to hike approximately 1 mile.



River Rambling

Ages 5 and up with an adult Session 1: Friday, July 12, 1-3 pm Session 2: Friday, August 9, 1-3 pm

Join a naturalist and step into the Milwaukee River! We'll explore this wonderful, watery world and seek out the creatures that call the river home. Bring your favorite closed toe wading shoes (old sneakers work best), a towel and a change of clothes. Expect to get wet: it's all part of the fun. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

SUMMER CAMP REGISTRATION

Registration for the Nature Journeys Summer Camps will be taken through our online registration system. You may access the registration system through the Summer Camp page on our website (click on the Summer Camp picture block on the Riveredge home page at www.riveredgenaturecenter.org). You can also navigate via our Programs page on the website, selecting "Come to Camp."

When registering, make sure you have all the medical information (insurance, primary doctor, medication, etc.) handy for each child you are registering. A medical information form is required during the registration process. Online registration will close the Wednesday before the week of each camp. Spaces may still be available at that time - call 262-375-2715 to ask about last-minute availability.



Camp Drop Off and Pick Up:

For the convenience of all, we're now using staggered start and end times for all camps. This allows families with multiple children the time needed to drop off and pick up at multiple locations. If you are not able to arrive during the 15 minute drop off window, you will be able to walk your child to their classroom. Extended care will be available to families who need a later pick up time.

Membership Discount:

Riveredge Family Membership (\$75 annually) will discount camp prices, ranging from \$15-\$30 per camp. Membership also provides many other benefits all year round! Visit RiveredgeNatureCenter.org/membership for more information.



Multiple Camps/Children Discount:

If you register for multiple camps (they can be for the same child or different children), you will pay the normal fee for the first camp and receive a 10% discount off of each additional camp. There is also a discount for registering multiple children from the same household for any combination of camps (first child full price, additional siblings 10% off). Please note that our registration system can sometimes have trouble when multiple discounts are applied. If this happens and your total doesn't look right, please pay 50% of the cost and contact Riveredge directly at 262-375-2715 to have the remaining balance adjusted. We're here to help and make sure you get all the discounts you qualify for!



Waitlist:

Riveredge camps are popular and fill QUICKLY! Waitlists will be formed when camps have reached their capacity. It is very beneficial to put your name on waitlists as spots do often open up due to family scheduling conflicts. There is no fee to put your child on the waitlist. If a space becomes available, you will be contacted via email, with 48 hours to confirm the spot and pay the deposit. If we do not hear from you within 48 hours, a call will be made and you will have an additional 48 hours to respond before the spot is given to the next person on the waitlist.

Payment:

50% of camp fees are due at the time of registration until April 30, 2024. Full payment for all camps is due by May 1st. You may make payments on your account at any time through the Active registration system using your log-in.



Camperships (like a scholarship, but for camp!):

Thanks to generous donors, Riveredge is able to offer camperships to families who may not otherwise be able to attend camp. Contact Steff Merten at smerten@riveredge.us for more information and an application. If you would like to donate to the campership fund, that can be done during camp registration or call 262-375-2715.

Cancellations:

Registrations may be canceled up to 30 days prior and receive a refund of registration fees minus a \$50 non-refundable deposit. If you cancel less than 30 days before your week of camp, refunds are only given for medical reasons and family emergencies. These refunds are also subject to the \$50 non-refundable deposit.



Switching Camps:

If you'd like to move your camp registration to another camp, we are happy to accommodate those requests as space allows. Each date/camp change is subject to a \$30 fee. Please contact us at 262-375-2715 to request a date change.

Camper Illness Policy:

All participants must be free from fever or vomiting without medication for a minimum of 24 hours before they may attend/return to camp. Please keep your child at home if they are not feeling well.
